

## **Checklist of the plants of Perthshire.**

Perthshire is a large county supporting diverse habitats ranging from some of Scotland's highest mountains to estuarine saltmarsh, and contains many classic botanical localities. Despite the county's botanical riches, the only published flora of Perthshire dates from as long ago as 1898. This 93-page checklist gives a more up-to-date perspective, and is the only more recent publication to cover all vascular plants and stoneworts (charophytes) recorded from the three Perthshire vice-counties up to end of 1991. The area covered differs from the modern administrative district, and includes the old counties of Perthshire and Clackmannanshire, plus a portion of Fife and fragments of Angus, Kinross and Stirlingshire.
